

Instructions for CBCA's 2024 Scholarship Program

Clayton Business & Community Association (CBCA) was founded in 1984 with the intent that it be an organization for the good of the entire community. Today CBCA has more than 200 members from all walks of life within Clayton and nearby cities. CBCA is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization.

Some of the activities CBCA organizes include: Art & Wine Festival, Oktoberfest, BBQ & Brews Festival, and Holidays in the Grove events. All of the profits raised by our various efforts are returned to the community in the form of donations and to support many charitable groups, Clayton's schools, and numerous civic improvements.

As part of our efforts to give back to the community, each year CBCA provides scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are going to continue their education. CBCA scholarships are one-year scholarships, to be disbursed in two installments. In 2024 the total amount to be awarded among the students selected to receive scholarships is \$40,000.

Any student applying for a CBCA scholarship must reside in the Clayton zip code of 94517, be a high school senior with plans to enroll in an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university or trade school, and carry at least 12 academic units per quarter/semester. Written applications will be reviewed by the CBCA Scholarship Committee and finalists will be interviewed by the Committee members.

The applicants will be judged based on criteria that includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- 1. Completeness of the application
- 2. Extra-curricular activities, including community service activities and volunteering
- 3. Academic achievement
- 4. Written and oral communication skills

All applications must be **received by <u>mail only</u>** at CBCA, Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 436, Clayton, CA 94517, and must be <u>post-marked no later than Thursday, April 4, 2024</u>. Applications that are not submitted in a timely manner will <u>not be considered</u>. Please read these instructions and the required list of attachments on the application form carefully.
